

Upper Hand Organization – Our Story

Upper Hand Organization (UHO) is a charitable foundation based in Chitral, Pakistan. It was established with a vision to help the helpless, serve humanity, and rebuild lives through sincere action. Founded by Fazal Wadood, this journey began as a personal mission and has now grown into an organized movement that brings relief, education, healthcare, housing, and employment opportunities to the people of northern Pakistan.

Clean Water Projects

We have completed more than forty-three water projects, including solarized water systems and pipeline installations in areas such as Sweer Lusht, Zareen Abad, Hakim Abad, and Usiak. These projects have ended the daily struggle for drinking water and improved the health and hygiene of thousands of families.

Medical Care

UHO has provided medical treatment to over seventy-two patients and supported dozens more across hospitals in Karachi, Timergara, and Peshawar. From transporting critical patients to paying hospital bills, we continue to ensure that no one is denied care due to poverty.

Education and Children ' s Support

Over one hundred and fifty students and orphans have received scholarships, fees, and school materials. During Eid and other events, special children and orphans are given shopping opportunities to celebrate with joy and dignity.

Flood and Disaster Relief

In 2022, floods struck Chitral, destroying villages like Boni, Brip, Gahgeer, and Broghul. UHO reached these areas with rations, clothes, and cash assistance. Again, in 2025, when Buner was hit by flash floods, UHO provided emergency aid and later began building twenty homes under the project 'Chat Ka Tuhfa' (Gift of Roof).

Housing for the Homeless

So far, forty-four homes have been built for poor and disabled families in places like Hakim Abad and Barinis. These homes provide shelter, safety, and dignity to families who once lived in tents and temporary shelters.

Mosques and Madrasas

Faith is central to our work. UHO has constructed seventy-four mosques and madrasas, including a landmark mosque in Katagal completed in 2025 with a budget of Rs 7 million.

Rozgar Scheme

Through our employment program, we help individuals start small businesses by providing them with tools, sewing machines, or shop setup funds. More than twenty people have already benefited, gaining self-reliance and confidence.

Community Packages

Our seasonal welfare packages—Ramadan, winter, and summer—are distributed every year to hundreds of widows, orphans, and low-income families. Each package includes food, clothing, and daily essentials.
